



#### **Confessions during Holy Week**

Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup>: The Church will be open for Confession and quiet prayer time from 6pm - 7:30pm

**Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup>:** Usual Holy Hour, with Confessions from 6pm – 7pm

Thursday 28th: Confessions after the Mass of the Lord's Supper

Friday 29<sup>th</sup>: Confessions after the Stations of the Cross – finishing at 12 noon

<u>Please Note</u>: No confessions after the Good Friday 3pm Lord's Passion and No Confessions on Holy Saturday.

For Catholics, the primary obligation is to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, especially during the Easter Season. The obligation to go to Confession before this reception of Communion is related to this Easter practice **so as to be sure of being in the state of grace**. After Confession, you can lead a happier and more devout Easter knowing God has cleansed your soul and forgiven you of your sins.

'Read Me' Bible Study Group: Meets every Saturday at 11:30am - 12:45pm.


# **Lent & Baptism**
